

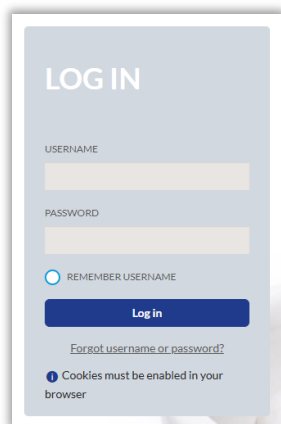
PTU: Student Guide

INTRODUCTION

Welcome to *Pharmacy Technicians University* (PTU). In the PTU program, training is delivered as an online, self-paced course. This document will provide you with instructions and information on using the PTU system.

LOGGING IN

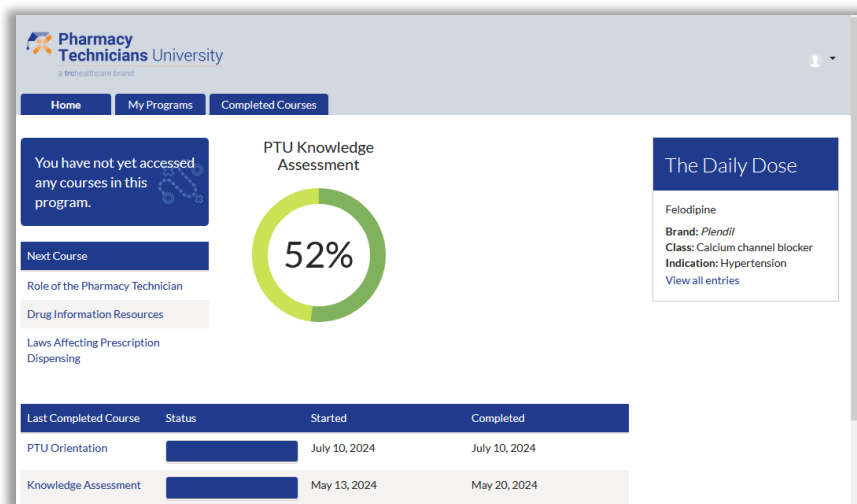

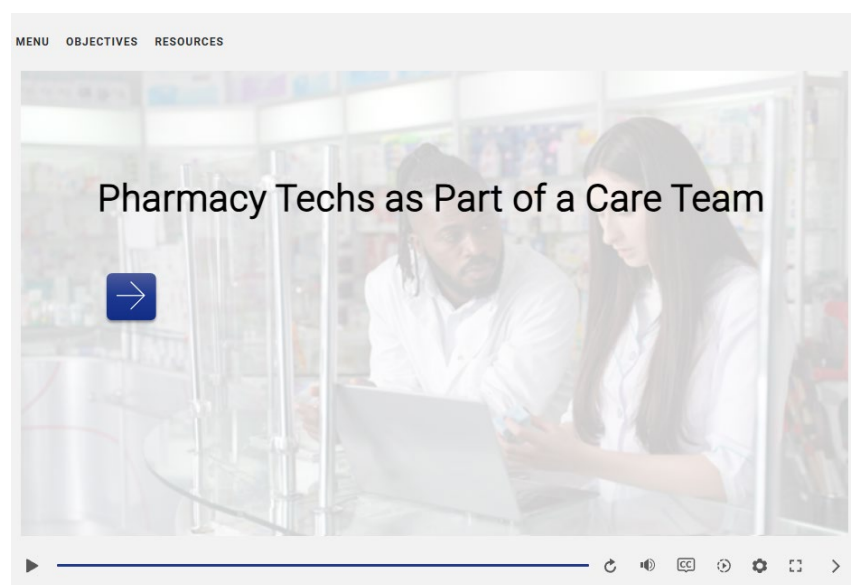

All courses have one or more activities. Most of the activities are focused on learning, while other activities include quizzes to test your knowledge. Once you complete an activity, a checkmark is placed in the box on the right-hand side.

If you've started a course but have not completed all the activities, you can use the "Pick up where you left off" link on your dashboard the next time you log in. This will take you back to the course you're working on.

MODULE STRUCTURE

Each course is broken into learning modules. Upon opening a module, you will be presented with a short audio description introducing the content. On the top left of the player screen are tabs that will allow you to view the learning objectives and any related resource documents.



QUIZ ACTIVITIES

There is at least one quiz activity for each module. You have **unlimited attempts** to complete the quiz with a score of **80% or better**. Your attempt is logged as soon as the quiz begins, whether you complete it or not. Make sure you have enough time to complete the quiz before you begin.

If you fail a quiz, we strongly suggest you review the learning module again before reattempting that quiz.

Optional Review Quizzes

At the bottom of each course you will find optional practice quizzes that will allow you to practice an unlimited number of times.

UNIT EXAMS AND MIDTERM EXAM

You will have **3 attempts** on the Unit Exams and Midterm Exam to earn a score of **80% or better**. The Unit Exams and Midterm Exam must be done in a single session. When you are ready to start the Unit Exams and Midterm Exam, be sure you have enough time to finish.

SUPPORTING MATERIALS

Some courses in PTU contain supporting materials. These can be PDFs to read, videos to watch, and/or articles from *Pharmacy Technician's Letter* to read. Make sure you read or watch these all the way through, as you will be quizzed on their content.

PDFs will likely open in a new window. Once you have read the document you can close that window. If the document opens in the same window as PTU, you can return to the course by clicking the back button on your browser.

Articles from *Pharmacy Technician's Letter* will open on the activity page. After you have read the article, you can click the 'back to course' button near the top of the screen. Or you can click the back button on your browser.

Videos. You'll have some videos that you watch and then click the 'back to course' button.

SIMULATION MODULES

Depending on the program that you are enrolled in, some of the courses contain Simulation modules. These modules present a practical task handled in the pharmacy and require you to demonstrate your handling of the task for your instructor to grade. When you open a simulation course, you'll find the following activities:

- Instructional video – is a step-by-step instruction of the task you are going to be asked to perform in the Challenge activity
- Instructional PDF – gives you the step-by-step information on the task completed in the instructional video in a written and printable format.
- Practice Exercises – gives you warm-up activities to prepare for the challenge activity.
- Challenge – gives specific instructions on the task to perform for your instructor. It also gives the criteria you'll be graded on, and your grading status.

REVIEW QUIZZES

Depending which Program you are assigned, the Program will include a review section to go over everything you've learned before you take the Final Exam. These review quizzes can be taken as often as you like, so be sure to use them until you have high confidence in each subject.

FINAL EXAM

You will have **3 attempts** on the Final Exam to earn a score of **75% or better**. The Final Exam must be done in a single session. When you are ready to start the Final Exam, be sure you have enough time to finish.

"COURSE OR ACTIVITY NOT ACCESSIBLE" MESSAGE

There are a few hard stops in PTU. If you click to open a course and get a message that the course or activity is not available, this means that there is something before that course that needs to be completed.
